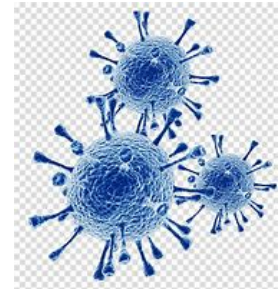




UNITY CLUB is reopening

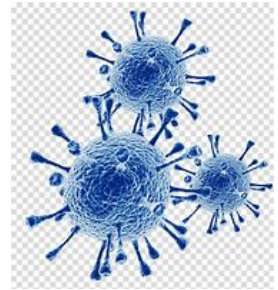
Please be patient with us as we navigate these times. We need your help to keep things safe and clean.

## COVID-19 RULES



These rules **MUST** be adhered to or you will be asked to leave the Unity Club:

It is up to **EACH MEETING CHAIR TO ENFORCE** these rules in their meeting

- Sick: If you have been feeling sick or anyone in your household  
– DO NOT ENTER!
- Fever: If you have a fever over 98.6  
– DO NOT ENTER
- Masks: **MUST** be worn at all times. We have some for purchase at the coffee bar if you don't have one.
- Capacity: Rooms will be set up to adhere to the **social distancing guidelines** – not to exceed 50 people in any one room. Once the chairs are full – the meeting is full and no one else will be permitted to join.  
(Suggestion: should people enter after capacity has been reached – some of you breakaway trying another room when possible– or a meeting in the parking lot. Never should you exceed the chairs available)
- Chips: No chips will be circulated at meetings
- Hugs/Holding Hands: Maintain social distancing...
- Big Book, 12\*12, As Bill Sees It Meetings: Suggest each group revise format - have only one person read passages - avoid mass handling of books.
- Donations: Secretary from each meeting should walk the basket around the room to collect donations - Not pass the basket.
