
If you've heard me in meetings, you've heard me say numerous times that on any given day I can be loony tunes. I understand that this program and life on life's terms takes effort. (See back)

Character defects such as self-righteous indignation and resentments pop up without notice When I feel that knot in my stomach I have to back up and ask "What is my role in all this?, What are my motives, and what am I supposed to learn?" That little litany and a bunch of meetings usually do the trick.

In the last two-years life has been more challenging than usual. Taking care of our last elder parent – long distance – has been stressful and time consuming. Last summer, we were called upon to witness her death. Before we could get over that loss – another family member had a sudden illness and died within 30 days. Not what I would have planned but because of this program I was able to be there for my husband and his family during this journey. Just doing the next right thing.

So, to quote my favorite passage in the 24-hour-a-day book: Life is not a search for happiness. Happiness is a by-product of living the right kind of a life, or doing the right thing. Do not search for happiness, search for right living and happiness will be your reward. Life is sometimes a march of duty during dull, dark days. But happiness will come again, as God's smile of recognition of your faithfulness. True happiness is always the by-product of a life well lived."
